Footpath reconstruction – Boree Avenue, Clarinda (Elder Street to Melaleuca Drive - south side)

We're improving the footpath along Boree Avenue, Clarinda, from Elder Street to Melaleuca Drive, to improve pedestrian safety.

The works will include:

- Reconstructing a 1.5m wide footpath on the southern side of Boree Avenue between Elder Street and Melaleuca Drive, with sections of permeable pavement to protect existing trees adjacent to the path.
- Upgrading pram crossings at both ends of Boree Avenue

Every year, we invest in Kingston's roads, paths, and drainage networks to support the current and future needs of our community. Please refer to the attached maps and plans for more details.

Construction Details

Construction is expected to take place in late 2026 and will take around 4-5 weeks to complete.

During the works, access to some pedestrian areas may be temporarily restricted. We'll work to minimise disruption and will provide clear signage for alternative pathways.

Additional details, including contact information for construction-related queries, will be shared closer to the commencement of works.

We look forward to delivering these improvements for the community.
