Bradina Court, Footpath Construction

Every year we invest significantly in Kingston's roads, paths, and drainage network to support the current and future needs of our community.

We plan to construct a section of footpath linking Bradina Court with Amaroo Drive Reserve, to improve the safety and accessibility for pedestrians and residents.

The improvements include:

- Construction of footpath between 13 and 20 Bradina Court
- Reconstruction of path within Amaroo Drive

Significant trees will be retained, and tree protection measures will be in place during the works.

Construction Details

Works are expected to be completed by late 2025 and will take around 2 weeks to complete. More specific information regarding timing of the works will be available when a contractor is appointed by Council.

The construction works will restrict access to some pedestrian areas for short periods of time. We will aim to minimise disruption and will provide adequate signage for alternative pathways.

Closer to the time of construction additional information will be provided, with details on who to contact during construction.

We look forward to delivering these improvements for the community.
