Precinct improvement work continues in Carrum, with boardwalk extension works

Our improvement works in the Carrum foreshore and Patterson River precinct continues, with Stage Two set to get underway this October. Stage Two will see us improving accessibility by extending the boardwalk further north. This will make it easier to move between the Patterson River path, the beach, the Stephens Street Car Park and the Beauty Spot Reserve. The works are complemented by the recently completed rejuvenation of the Beauty Spot Reserve, home to the local War Memorial.

Stage Two will get underway from October until mid-December, with a break during the peak summer season. It will then resume in February until completion in March 2025.

Thanks to your feedback, we have been working to deliver the following improvements in this precinct:

Stage One: The Beauty Spot Memorial Upgrade
 The works includes new paths, new seating and picnic tables, sensory garden and walkway, feature art
 sculpture, signage, drinking fountain, bicycle racks, bins, and lighting.

• Stage Two: Carrum Boardwalk Extension to Patterson River

The works include: extending the boardwalk further north with improved connectivity to the Patterson River Path, the Stephens Street Car Park and the beach. The new boardwalk will have handrails, tactile indicators, a viewing platform with seating, interpretive signage, and solar bollard lighting. *Commencing October 2024*

Stage Three: Stephens Street Car Park Improvements and Wayfinding Signage
 The works at the Stephens Street Car Park (next to the Beauty Spot and Patterson River), include a
 pavement upgrade, incorporating two new fully compliant accessible parking bays, line-marking,
 signage, and solar lighting.

We aim for these works to be completed by mid-2025

All significant trees will be retained, and tree protection measures will be in place during the works. To see more, view the plans over the page.
