We are refreshing Cavanagh Street, Cheltenham

Kingston is home to many vibrant local shopping precincts, which bring people together, offering personalised connections with traders and a strong sense of local identity.

A much loved area for locals is the Cavanagh Street shopping strip in Cheltenham (between Friendship Square and Dewrang Street) which is now in need of a refresh.

We are creating a more inviting and accessible space for locals to enjoy for years to come. Our draft concept plan includes:

- widening of footpath in front of 85-99 Cavanagh Street to improve pedestrian safety and accessibility
- a new accessible parking bay in front of 85 Cavanagh Street
- creation of a new paved area with landscaping, garden beds, seating and table near Frank's Café
- relocation of the existing Telstra phone box slightly further along the strip to allow better use of the space
- new street furniture including seating, bins and bicycle hoops along the strip
- new trees and landscaping enhancing biodiversity and making the shopping strip more vibrant and inviting

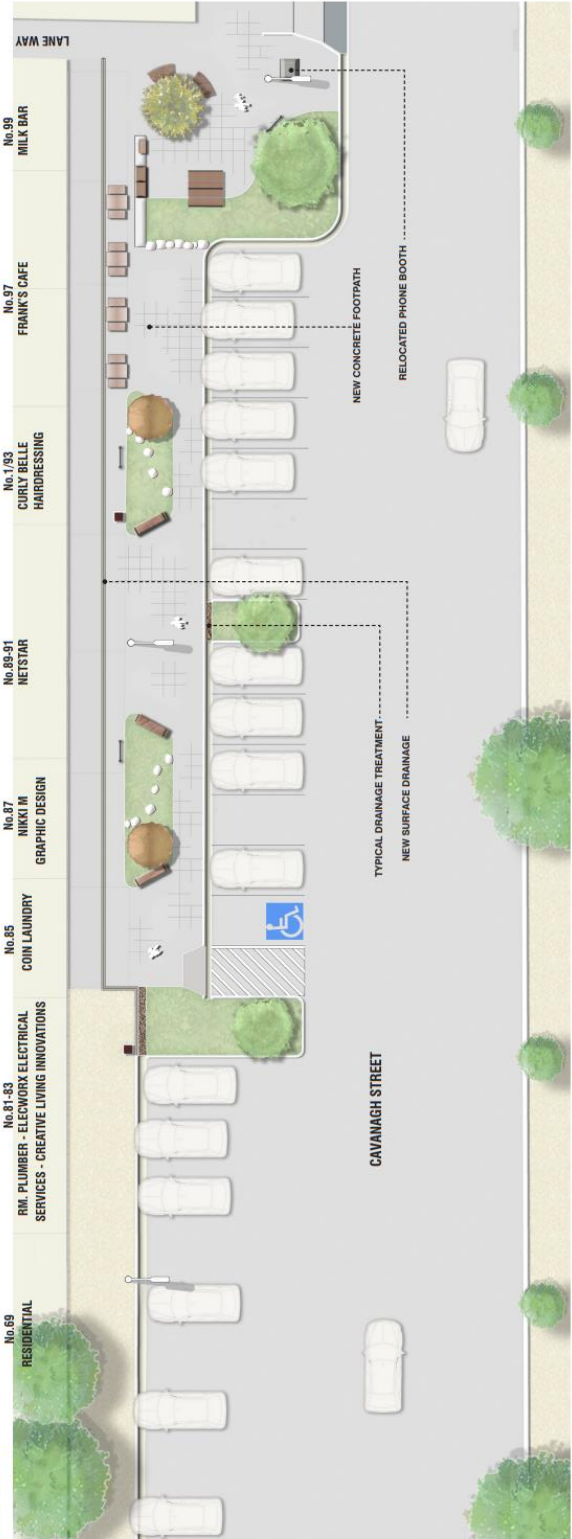

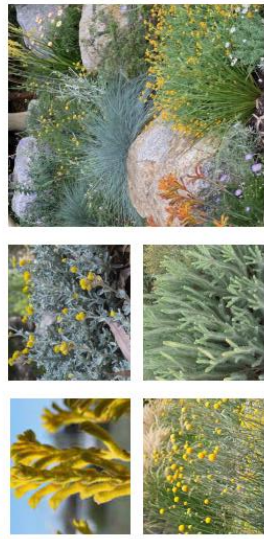
