Church Road, Carrum – Drainage Outfall Construction (Stage 2)

Kingston City Council is continuing improvements to Church Road following the recent completion of stage 1, which delivered road upgrades and drainage improvements between Eel Race Road and 45 Church Road.

We are now preparing for stage 2, which will further strengthen the local drainage network and help manage stormwater more effectively during heavy rainfall.

What's happening next

We are preparing to commence stage 2 works, which include construction of a new drainage outfall into Kananook Creek near the Church Road and Eel Race Road intersection. This will improve drainage performance in the area and reduce the risk of overland water flow.

The stage 2 works include:

- Reconstructing kerb and channel along Eel Race Road
- Installing a new concrete drainage pipe and connecting it to the existing drainage pit
- Adding rock features along the creek bank to help protect and reduce erosion at the pipe outlet.
- Installing a safety barrier fencing around the outlet

All significant trees will be retained and protected throughout the works. Any vegetation removed will be offset with new plantings to support local biodiversity.

Timing of works

Stage 2 is expected to start in Autumn 2026 and be completed by mid-2026. Once the contractor is appointed, we will provide a more detailed construction schedule and information about any temporary access or traffic impacts.

Please note: A previous bulletin incorrectly advised that the next stage of works would commence in late 2025. The updated timeframe now sees Stage 3 (the next road reconstruction stage) beginning in 2027 sometime after the drainage outfall works are complete.
