Dane Road Reserve, Moorabbin Sports Lighting Project

We're pleased to advise nearby residents that we are moving ahead with our plans to install sports lighting at Dane Road Reserve in Moorabbin following our success at securing funding from the Victorian Government. This funding will allow us to continue working with the Racing Rugby Club of Melbourne to encourage greater participation in Junior Rugby Union.

Project details

The project includes the installation of 4 new light towers on the sports oval at Dane Road Reserve to bring it up to standard for night training and games during the winter season and ensure it is consistent with Rugby Lighting Standards and include light spill management.

Please see the map overleaf for pole locations.

Energy-efficient fittings will be used throughout, and each light tower will measure 20 metres in height with 4 luminaires on each pole. The operational hours of the lights will be from dusk until 10 PM.

Installation timing and impacts

The sports lighting project is due to commence in January, and will take approximately 4 months to complete, subject to weather and materials delivery.

Access to Dane Road Reserve will be maintained throughout the works, with temporary fencing surrounding the dedicated works zones for the safety of the community. We apologise for any inconvenience and will minimise disruption wherever possible.
