Famechon Road and Hughes Avenue, Edithvale – Intersection Improvements

Every year we invest significantly in Kingston's roads, paths, and drainage network to support the current and future needs of our community.

We plan to reconstruct the intersection of Hughes Avenue and Famechon Road to improve safety and access.

The improvements include:

- Reconstruction of the traffic island, pram ramps and footpath
- Reconstruction of the vehicle crossing at 64 Hughes Avenue
- Widening of the intersection

Significant trees will be retained, and tree protection measures will be in place during the works.

Construction Details

The project is expected to be undertaken in mid-2026 and will take approximately 4 weeks to complete. More specific information regarding the timing of works will be available when a contractor is appointed by Council.

Additional information will be provided closer to the time of construction, including details on who to contact during this period.

We look forward to delivering these improvements for the community.

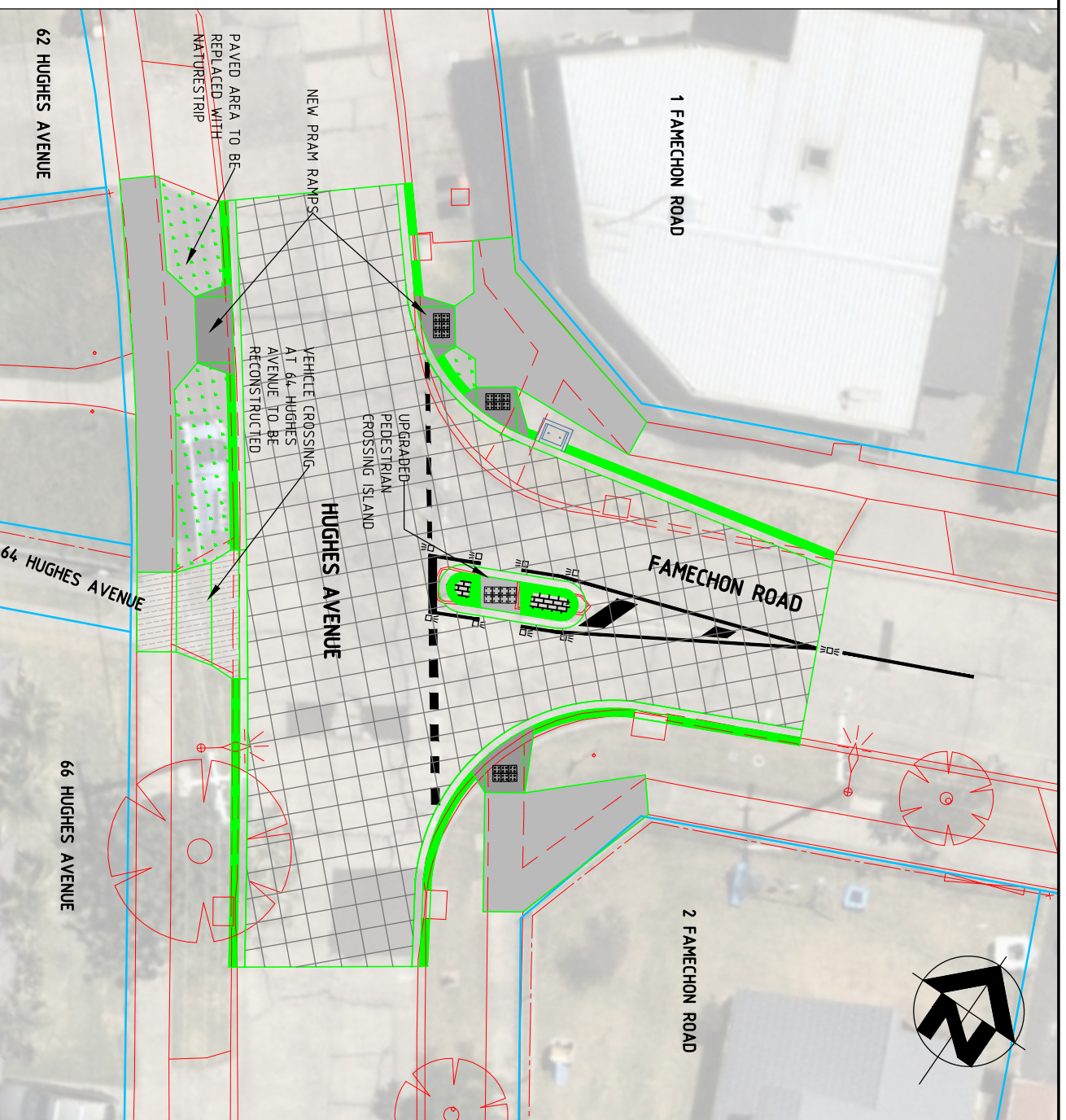
