Gladesville Boulevard, Patterson Lakes, Shared User Path Construction

We plan to construct a shared user path to improve connectivity between Gladesville Boulevard and the Peninsula Link Trail, improving safety for pedestrians and the community.

The improvements include:

- Construction of new path between Gladesville Boulevard and the Peninsula Link Trail.
- Reconstruction of the residential vehicle crossing of 1/1A Gladesville Boulevard.
- Construction of a speed cushion on the Southbound lane of Gladesville Boulevard.

Tree protection measures will be in place during the works, and significant trees will be retained.



Construction Details

Works are expected to be completed by the end of 2025 and will take approximately 6 weeks to complete. Specific information regarding timing of the works will be available when a contractor is appointed.

There may be times when some residents have limited access to their properties and nearby pedestrian areas during the works. We will inform affected residents beforehand, provide signs for alternative routes, and try to minimise disruptions to the community. Additional information will be provided closer to the commencement of the work, with details on who to contact during construction.

We look forward to delivering these improvements for the community.
