## Remediation works at Heatherton Park, Clayton South

As part of our commitment to improving our open spaces in Kingston, we developed a masterplan for Heatherton Park, a former landfill, to guide long-term planning for the site.

Before we can move forward with future improvements, initial remediation works are required to prepare the site for development, including the removal of three inactive gas monitoring stations.

### Timing and impacts

Removal works are expected to start in mid-April and will take approximately 1 week to complete, weather permitting.

Specialist machinery will be used to safely decommission and remove the three gas monitoring stations in accordance with environmental and safety requirements.

Please refer to the map overleaf for the locations of the three inactive gas monitoring stations.

During the works, access to Heatherton Park will be maintained, with appropriate pedestrian and site safety management in place. Nearby residents may notice an increase in truck and machinery movements, which may result in temporary noise and ground disturbances.

We apologise for any inconvenience and will minimise disruption wherever possible.
