McLeod Road/Manhattan Court, Patterson Lakes - Footpath construction and path upgrade.

Every year we invest significantly in Kingston's roads, footpath, and drainage network to support the current and future needs of our community to create a cycling and pedestrian-friendly Kingston.

We plan to construct a footpath at 238 McLeod Road and upgrade (widen) the existing footpath along Manhattan Court to match the existing path. This will improve access and safety for pedestrians.

The improvements include:

- A new footpath along at 238 McLeod Road to help students cross safely.
- Upgrade existing pram ramp to match the opposite ramp.
- Upgrade to the existing footpath in Manhattan Court to 2.5m wide in-line with the existing path.

Construction Details

We estimate the works will take three to four weeks to complete between September – November 2025.
