Park Street/Albert Street intersection, Mordialloc – Footpath construction

We recently shared proposed plans for a new footpath connection at the intersection of Park Street and Albert Street, to improve safety and connectivity for our community.

Community feedback was carefully considered, and the proposed works have been updated to reflect feedback that was received.

Updated improvements include (please refer to plan overleaf for more detail):

- Construction of a new concrete footpath along the traffic island
- New pram crossings with tactile indicators

The extension of the traffic island is no longer included and the left turn from Albert Street onto Park Street will be retained.

Construction Details

The works will take approximately 4 weeks to complete and are planned to commence in 2025 (subject to staging with the level crossing removal works to minimise disruption to the community).

Construction works will restrict access to some pedestrian areas for short periods. Council will endeavour to minimise disruption and will provide adequate signage for alternative pathways.

Closer to the time of construction additional information will be provided, with details on who to contact during construction.

We apologise for any inconvenience during the works and look forward to delivering these improvements for the community.
