Safer crossings for Waves Leisure Centre, Chesterville Road, Highett.

Late last year we made a commitment to deliver 68 projects to improve the experience of walking and cycling in Kingston; and have already completed 10 of these.

We are now getting ready to start work on new pedestrian crossings in front of Waves Leisure Centre on Chesterville Road, Highett, to improve safety and access for our community.

The improvements will include:

- The construction of new pram crossings in front of Waves Leisure Centre.
- Construction of a new splitter island between the new pram crossings at Chesterville Road.
- Reconstruction of the section of footpath behind the new pram crossings, to match with the new path and provide access to Waves Leisure Centre.

Significant trees will be retained, and tree protection measures will be in place during the works. For more details, please refer to the plans, on the following page.

Construction Details

Works are expected to commence by early 2025 and will take around 4 weeks to complete.

More specific information regarding timing of the works will be available when a contractor is appointed by Council.

During construction there may be temporary restrictions to pedestrian access. We will aim to minimise any disruption, and will provide adequate signage for alternative pathways. Closer to the time of construction additional information will be provided, with details on who to contact.

We look forward to delivering these improvements for the community.
