Proposed road construction works - Swanston Street, Mentone

Later in 2025, we'll work to repair dilapidated Council assets and improve vehicle access along Swanston Street, Mentone.

The work we undertake will include:

- Reconstruction of the asphalt road pavement
- New concrete kerbs, vehicle crossings, pram ramps, and small sections of footpath.

Construction details

Work is planned to commence in mid- 2025, and is expected to be completed within a four-week period.

During work, there may be short-term parking restrictions, and the road may be closed to through traffic at times. Delays can be expected in the works zone. Nature strips and footpaths close to these works may be used to store construction materials or portable buildings.

The construction site will be maintained in a tidy and safe condition at all times.

Access to neighbouring properties will be maintained, where possible, throughout the construction. Shortterm vehicle access restrictions to properties will apply, while vehicle crossings are replaced. Residents with special access needs are encouraged to discuss their requirements with the contacts listed below.
