Footpath construction – Warren Road, Parkdale (Clare Street to Brisbane Terrace - West side)

We're improving the footpath along Warren Road, Parkdale, from Clare Street to Brisbane Terrace.

The works will include:

- a new 1.5m wide footpath on the western side of Warren Road to improve pedestrian safety and connectivity between Clare Street and Brisbane Terrace
- minor drainage improvements.

Every year, we invest in Kingston's roads, paths, and drainage networks to support the current and future needs of our community. Please refer to the attached maps and plans for more details.

Construction Details

Construction is expected to take place in Autumn 2026 and will take around five to six weeks to complete.

During the works, access to some pedestrian areas may be temporarily restricted. We'll work to minimise disruption and will provide clear signage for alternative pathways.

Additional details, including contact information for construction-related queries, will be shared closer to the commencement of works.

We look forward to delivering these improvements for the community.
