Warren Road, Parkdale (Lower Dandenong Road to Reid Street) – West Side Footpath Reconstruction

Every year we invest significantly in Kingston's roads, paths, and drainage network to support the current and future needs of our community.

We are planning to reconstruct the existing footpath along Warren Road, from Lower Dandenong Road to Reid Street, to improve safety and connectivity for our community.

The improvements are shown on the following page. All existing street trees will be retained and protected during the works.

Construction Details

Works are expected to be completed by the end of 2025 and will take approximately 4 weeks to complete. More specific information regarding timing of the works will be available when a contractor is appointed by Council.

To enable the works and maintain public safety, there may be times when some residents have restricted access to their properties and pedestrian areas. We will contact impacted properties in advance, provide adequate signage for alternative pathways and endeavour to minimise any inconvenience for the community.

Closer to the time of construction additional information will be provided, with details on who to contact during construction.

We look forward to delivering these improvements for the community.


