## **Proposed Footpath construction – Malcolm Road, Braeside**

Each year the City of Kingston invests over \$10 million in roads and footpath network infrastructure to support the current and future needs of our community.

As part of Council's industrial strategy, a concrete footpath will be constructed along the southern side of Malcolm Road to improve safety and amenity for pedestrians and local business operators.

This project will include works over the existing bridge that crosses the concrete channel to provide a pedestrian link between Boundary Road and Macbeth Street. Refer to the enclosed map for details.

### **Construction Details**

Works are scheduled to commence in June 2021 and will take around 6 weeks to complete.

The construction works will restrict access to some properties for short periods, including the vehicle crossings at No. 20-30 and No.16-18 Malcolm Road which will need to be replaced to allow for the construction of the new path. Council will endeavour to minimise disruption during these works.

Closer to the time of construction an additional bulletin will be provided, with detailed information on who to contact if any issues arise during construction.
