

Bunjil Ward



This ward is named in honour of Bunjil, the wedge-tailed eagle, the creator deity of the local indigenous people of Kingston, the Bunurong People of the Kulin Nation.

There were **18,473** people estimated to be living in Bunjil in 2019, this makes up 11% of the Kingston population.

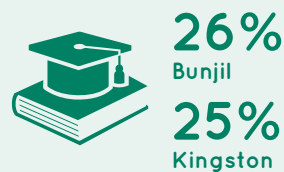

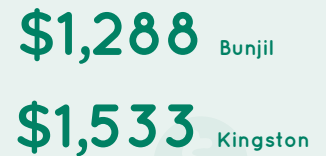
