

Kingston City Council
Instrument of Delegation
To Planning Committee

Kingston City Council (**Council**) delegates to the committee originally established by resolution of Council passed on 13 December 2010 and known as the "Planning Committee" (**the Committee**), the powers, discretions and authorities set out in the Schedule, and declares that:

1. this Instrument of Delegation is authorised by a resolution of Council passed on 23 April 2019;
2. the delegation
 - 2.1 comes into force upon the resolution of Council;
 - 2.2 remains in force until Council resolves to vary or revoke it; and
 - 2.3 is to be exercised in accordance with the exceptions, conditions and limitations set out in the Schedule and with the guidelines or policies which Council from time to time adopts; and
3. all members of the Committee have voting rights.

SCHEDULE

Purpose and Delegation

To exercise Council's powers, discretions and authorities to perform Council's functions under the *Planning and Environment Act 1987* in accordance with relevant policies and guidelines of the Council and to do all things necessary or convenient to be done for or in connection with the exercise and performance those powers, discretions, authorities and functions.

Membership

Comprises of all Councillors.

Quorum

A quorum for the Planning Committee is five (5).

Meeting Intervals

The Committee is to meet at intervals as specified by Council at the Statutory Meeting each year, and at other times as determined by the Chief Executive Officer and notified to the Committee members.

Exceptions, conditions and limitations

The Committee is not authorised by this Instrument to exercise the powers which, under section 86 of the *Local Government Act 1989* or section 188 of the *Planning and Environment Act 1987*, cannot be delegated to the Committee.
