Footpath construction – Birch Street, Mentone

Each year the City of Kingston invests over \$10 million in roads and footpath network infrastructure to support the current and future needs of our community.

Following requests from residents in your area, Council is planning to construct a concrete footpath along the grass nature strip on the north side of Birch Street. These works will require the removal of the tree in front of 2 Birch Street due to poor health and some vegetation trimming in front of 4 Birch Street.

Constructing a new footpath on the north side of Birch Street requires less vegetation/tree removal than the south side. Please refer to the enclosed plan for details.

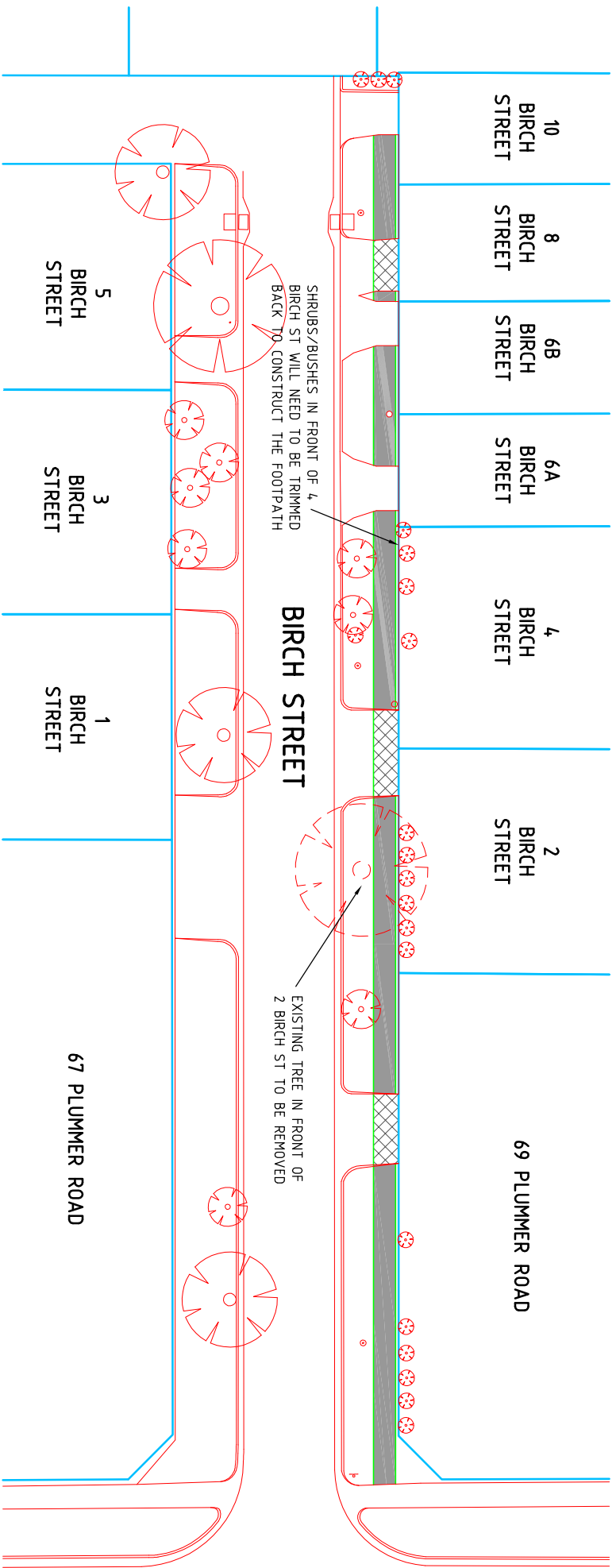
Construction Details

Works are scheduled for March 2022 and will take around 2 weeks to complete. Council will endeavour to minimise disruption but access to driveways could be restricted for short periods.



