## **Footpath construction – Como Parade East, Parkdale**

Each year the City of Kingston invests over \$10 million in roads and footpath network infrastructure to support the current and future needs of our community.

Council is planning to construct a concrete footpath along the naturestrip outside 195 and 197 Como Parade East to link the existing concrete footpaths along Como Parade East. This link will remove a dangerous pram crossing on the corner outside No. 197 and provide a safer route for pedestrians to Parkers Road. All the existing naturestrip trees will be retained. However, the existing brick path and garden beds along the path route outside No. 197 will need to be removed.

Please refer to the attached plan for details.

### **Construction Details**

Works are scheduled for March 2022 and will take around 2 weeks to complete. Council will endeavour to minimise disruption but access to driveways could be restricted for short periods.



