## Carinya Reserve Playspace Renewal

As part of our ongoing investment towards creating an active community, Council is renewing the Carinya Reserve playground.

In late 2020 Council consulted with the community regarding the playspace design and we thank everyone that provided feedback.

We heard from residents they wanted equipment to provide play experiences for children with disabilities and improved access for wheelchair-bound users. We are writing to nearby residents to provide an updated plan based on the feedback received.

The renewal will feature a new neighbourhood-level playspace with play equipment for children of all ages. Images of new equipment are shown at Appendix 2.

Accessible play items will include a basket swing, ground spinner, sand play and equipment will be accessible by a rubber softfall path.

At neighbourhood-level playspaces Council provides new park furniture, including a picnic shelter and picnic tables. New gardens beds and shade trees are also planned.

## Construction timeframes

Works are expected to commence mid-2022.
