Carrum Beach boardwalk scour protection and vehicle access works

To protect the foundations of the Carrum Beach boardwalk, Council is planning on extending the sloping rock wall along the southern edge of the boardwalk adjacent to the vehicle access way.

In addition, to stabilise the surface of the vehicle access, which frequently experiences sand scouring, an interlocking concrete block ramp will be installed. The ramp has been designed to adjust to the varying sand levels, which will ensure uninterrupted access for maintenance and lifesaving club vehicles.

Construction impacts

Access to the beach at this location will be disrupted at times during construction works, however alternative access will be available at the lifesaving club and at both the north and south ends of the car park.

We apologise for any inconvenience during the works and will minimise disruption wherever possible, while maintaining a safe work site.

Timeframes

Weather permitting, work is set to commence in July 2021 and is anticipated to take 3-4 weeks.

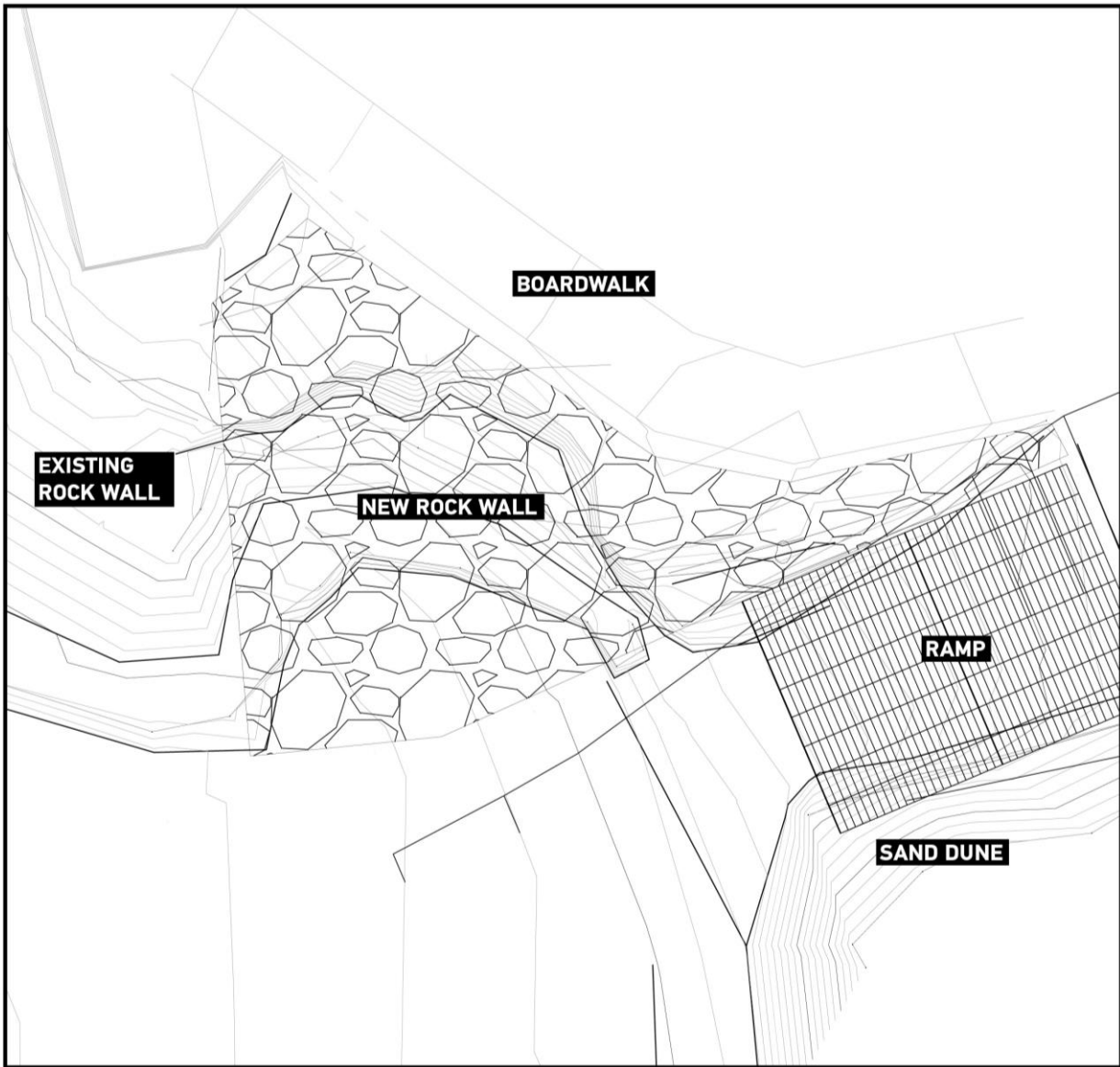

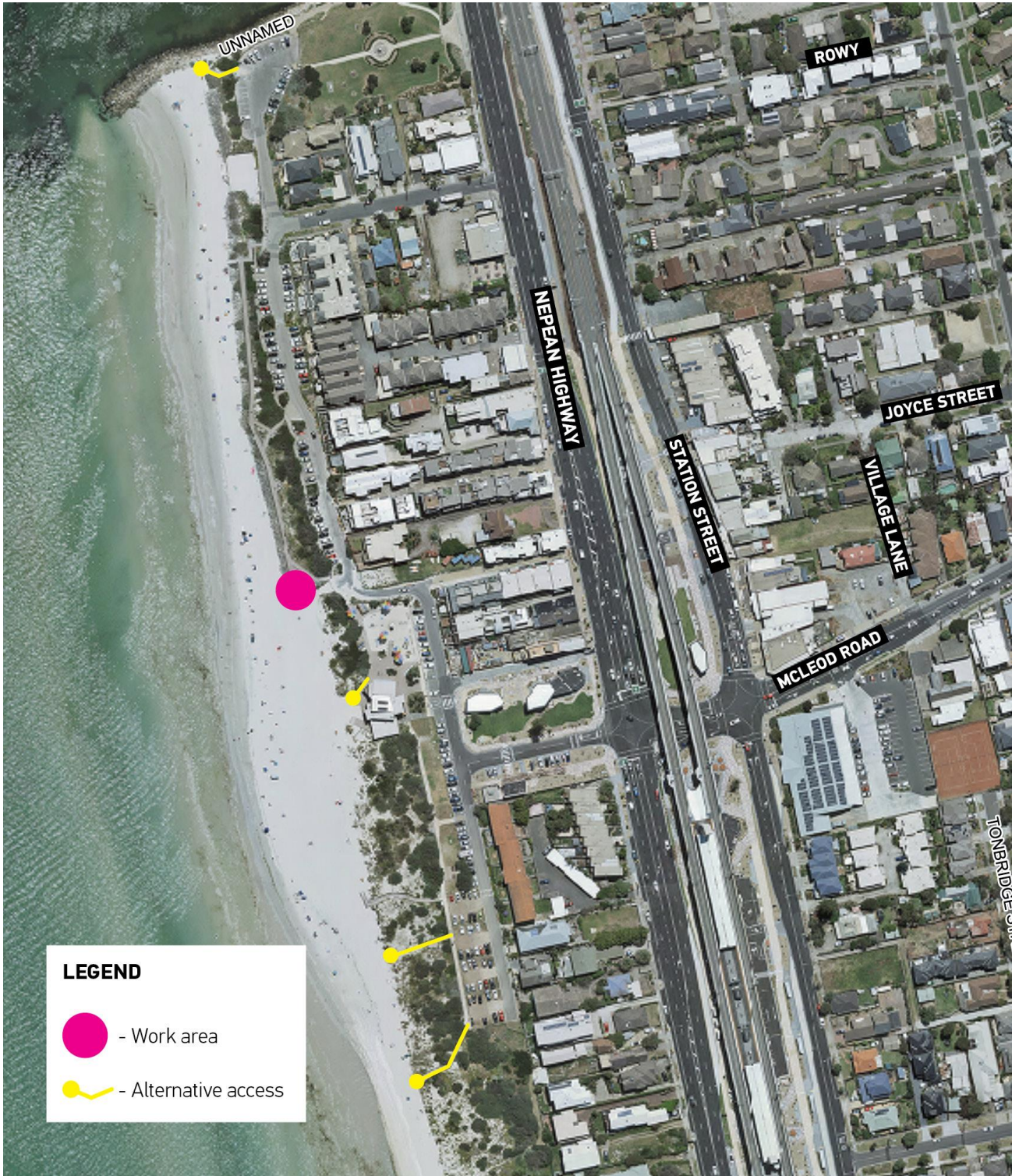
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Ramp and wall render
