New pocket park in Horscroft Place Moorabbin

In June 2020 Council consulted with the community regarding a new pocket park in Horscroft Place Moorabbin, with the intention of improving the streetscape and accessibility from Moorabbin station and the shops, through to Moorabbin Reserve and beyond to the Hospital and TAFE.

The project is being supported by the Victorian Government through the Local Parks Program.

A concept plan was developed in December 2020, which was shared with the community for feedback. Thank you to everyone that provided input. Council has revised the plan based on the comments provided and the new plan can be viewed overleaf.

Key elements of the project include:

- Direct path link through the park for cyclists and pedestrians
- Custom arbour structures
- Bespoke social seating & table
- Concrete bench seats
- Open lawn spaces
- Lighting
- Drinking fountain and bins
- New plantings, including new canopy shade trees.
- Potential mural artwork.

During boundary realignment some trees will need to be removed (see overleaf). In line with Council direction, a minimum of three new trees will be planted for each one removed.

Construction impacts and timeframes

Park construction will commence in October 2021 and is anticipated to be completed by the end of the year.

Access will be limited while the new path is being constructed. but we will endeavour to allow thoroughfare at other times during construction whilst maintaining a safe environment.

We apologise for any inconvenience during the works and will minimise disruption wherever possible.
