Kearney Reserve Playspace Renewal

As part of our ongoing investment towards creating an active community, Council is renewing the Kearney Reserve playground.

In late 2020 Council consulted with the community regarding the playspace design and we thank everyone that provided feedback.

We heard from residents they wanted more equipment and improved access for wheelchair-bound users, an obstacle 'ninja warrior unit' and equipment for older children. We are writing to nearby residents to provide an updated plan based on the feedback received.

The renewal will feature a new neighbourhood level play-space with play equipment for children of all ages. Images of new equipment are shown at Appendix 2.

The equipment will be accessible by a rubber soft-fall path.

At neighbourhood level play-spaces Council provides new park furniture, including a picnic shelter and picnic tables. New gardens beds and shade trees are also planned.

Construction timeframes

Works are expected to commence mid-2022.
