Rock Wall Construction – old Patterson River Motor Boat Club Site

Following the demolition of the Patterson River Motor Boat Club in 2020, Council is planning the construction of a rock wall to protect the abutting dune and car park area from erosion (see map overleaf).

The rock wall will match the existing wall either side of the former boat club site and will enclose the existing bluestone wall. The adjoining steps will be removed to achieve the necessary slope and stability of the rock wall.

Future plans for the site, such as extending the boardwalk on top of the wall north to the river, installing viewing platforms with seating, or any other form of development, will be put forward to the community during formal consultation at a later date during the development of Council's Marine and Coastal Management Plan (CMMP). In the interim, the area behind the new rock wall will be planted with low-lying coastal species.

Construction impacts

Access to the northern section of car park and access to and along this section of beach will be restricted at times during construction.

We apologise for any inconvenience during the works and will minimise disruption wherever possible, while maintaining a safe work site.

Construction timeframes

Construction is anticipated to commence in July 2021 and is expected to take 3-4 weeks, subject to weather.
