Notice of Proposed Budget 2016-2017

At its meeting on 26 April 2016, Kingston City Council resolved that the Proposed Budget for the financial year 1 July 2016 to 30 June 2017 be advertised.

Any person may make a written submission regarding the Proposed Budget. **All submissions must be received before 5.00 pm on 27 May 2016** and will be considered in accordance with section 223 (1) of the Local Government Act 1989, by Council at a Special Meeting of Council.

If a person wishes to be heard in support of their submission they must include the request to be heard in the written submission and this will entitle them to appear in person, or by a person acting on their behalf. Please note that copies of submissions (including submitters' names and addresses) will be made available at the Council meeting at which the above proposal will be considered. Council is also required to make submissions available for public inspection for a period of twelve months.
