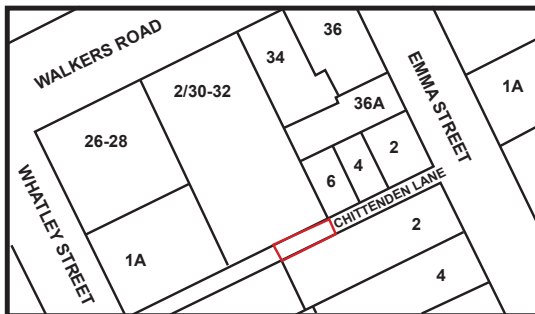


Proposed intention to discontinuance and sale of land adjoining 2 Emma Street Carrum



Kingston City Council, acting under Section 206 and Clause 3 of Schedule 10 of the Local Government Act 1989 ("the 1989 Act") and under Section 114 of the Local Government Act 2020 ("the 2020 Act"), gives notice of its intention to discontinue and sell the portion of road shown **bolded in red** on the plan below to the adjoining owner at 2 Emma Street Carrum (the Proposal) in accordance with the provisions of Council's 2017 "Discontinuance & Sale of Roads, Rights of Way & Drainage Reserves" Policy.

In accordance with Section 223 of the 1989 Act and Council's Community Engagement Policy, any person may make a submission on the proposal. Any person proposing to make a submission must do so by the close of business on Monday 28 November 2021.

A person making a submission may request to be heard in support of their submission. Any person requesting to be heard is entitled to appear in person or by a person acting on their behalf before a meeting of Council or Committee of Council.

Following consideration of any submissions, Council may decide to discontinue, or not discontinue the road, and either sell, or not to sell, the land from the discontinued road.
