

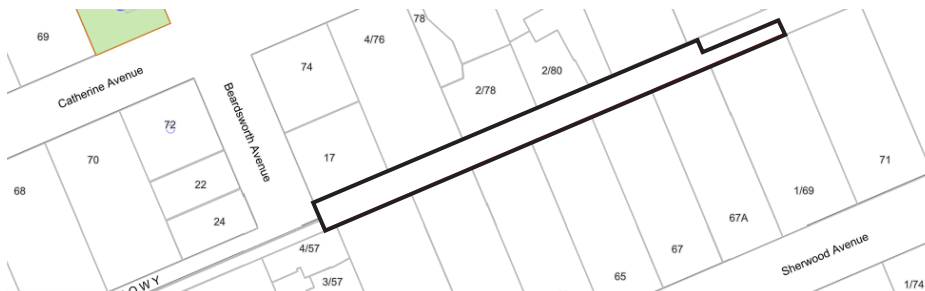
Notice of intention to sell land



Kingston City Council (Council) gives notice under section 114 of the Local Government Act 2020 ("the Act") and under Council's Community Engagement Policy of its intention to sell part of the land from the Drainage Reserve (Reserve) outlined in black on the plan below to the adjoining owners of 59–69 Sherwood Avenue Chelsea, 76-82 Catherine Avenue Chelsea and 17 Beardsworth Ave Chelsea, where the Reserve abuts their respective properties. Council proposes to sell the land(s) by private treaty in accordance with its 2017 Discontinuance & Sale of Roads, Rights of way & Drainage Reserves Policy

These proposed sales would follow the removal of the reserve status from the land and the subdivision of the land pursuant to Section 24A of the Subdivision Act 1988.

A person may make a submission on the proposal. Any person proposing to make a submission must do so by the close of business on Friday 12 November 2021.

A person making a submission may request in the submission that the person wishes to appear in person, or be represented by a person acting on their behalf before a meeting of Council (or of a committee of Council determined by the Council) to be heard in support of the submission,

Following consideration of submissions, if any, Council may decide to sell, or not to sell, the subject lands.
