

Proposed Naming Mayfield Park



Kingston City Council is undertaking community consultation on the proposed naming of a currently unnamed park located at Bond Street Mordialloc. Council are proposing to name the park 'Mayfield Park' in recognition of Mayfield Mansion which was previously located on the site.

The site of the park is shown below.



In order to proceed with this naming proposal, Council must follow the Guidelines for Geographic Names 2010 (version 2), provided by the Department of Transport, Planning and Local Infrastructure which includes consultation with the public (the naming guidelines may be viewed at www.dtpli.vic.gov.au/property-and-land-titles/naming-places-features-and-roads/guidelines-for-naming-or-proposing-to-name-or-rename-a-place).

1. Do you support the proposed name, Mayfield Park?
2. If you do not support the name, please provide reasons.
