

Notice of Proposed Budget 2014-2015

At its meeting on 10 June 2014, Kingston City Council resolved that the Proposed Budget for the financial year 1 July 2014 to 30 June 2015 be advertised.

Copies of the Proposed Budget are available for inspection from 12 June 2014 to 9 July 2014 during opening hours at Council's Customer Service Centres and Libraries. The Proposed Budget is also available on Council's website www.kingston.vic.gov.au.

Any person may make a written submission regarding the Proposed Budget. **All submissions must be received before 5.00 pm on 9 July 2014** and will be considered in accordance with section 223 (1) of the Local Government Act 1989, by Council at a Special Meeting of Council.

If a person wishes to be heard in support of their submission they must include the request to be heard in the written submission and this will entitle them to appear in person, or by a person acting on their behalf. A Special Meeting of Council will be held at 6.00pm on 21 July 2014, 1230 Nepean Highway, Cheltenham to consider submissions received.

Please note that copies of submissions (including submitters' names and addresses) will be made available at the Council meeting at which the above proposal will be considered. Council is also required to make submissions available for public inspection for a period of twelve months.
