## Haines Street, Cheltenham – Proposed Parking Changes

Council is responding to community concerns regarding the on-street parking restrictions on Haines Street in Cheltenham. To provide balanced parking opportunity for both short and longer-term parking on Haines Street, Council is proposing the following changes.

### Council Action

Council is seeking your feedback on the proposed parking changes to Haines Street (please see map overleaf):

**Option 1:** Removal of '4P 8am-5pm Mon-Fri' restrictions on the even numbered side of Haines Street.

**Option 2:** Removal of '4P 8am-5pm Mon-Fri' restrictions on the odd numbered side of Haines Street.

**Option 3:** No change to parking conditions.

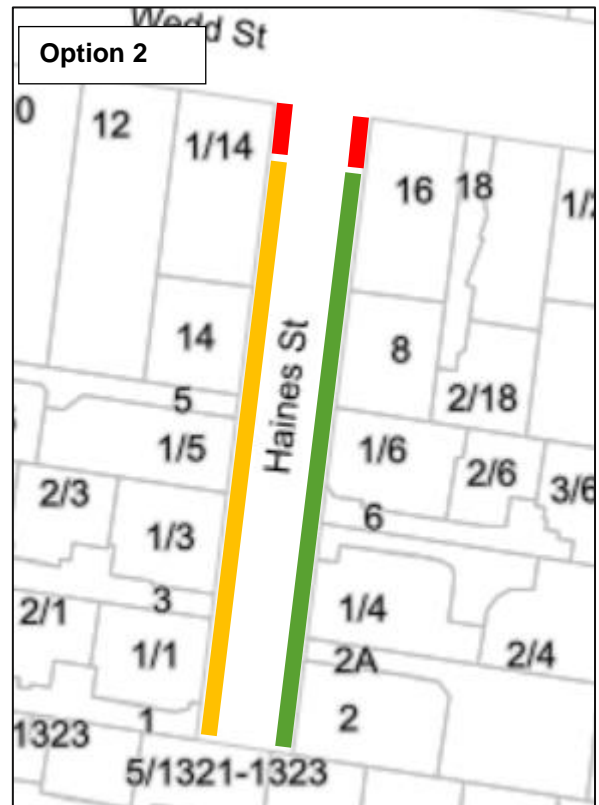
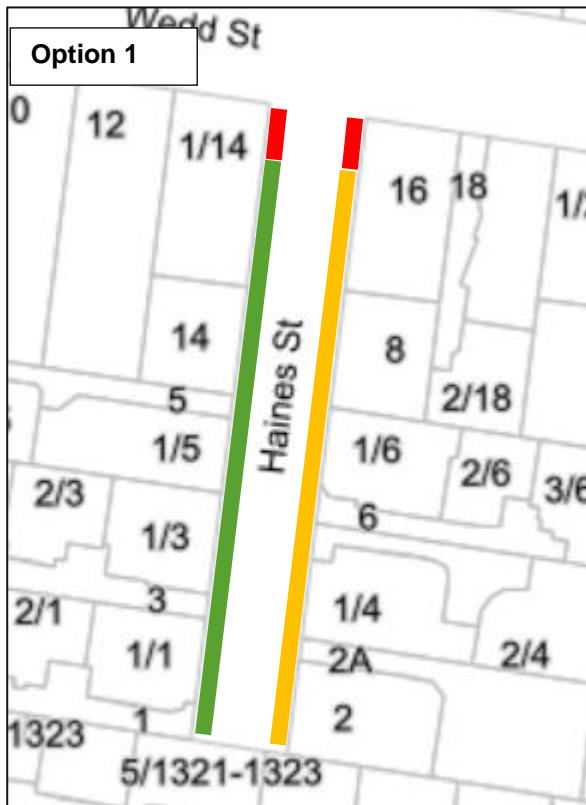
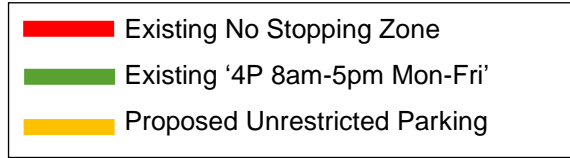
