Council is seeking your opinion on the following changes in Keith Avenue (please see map overleaf):

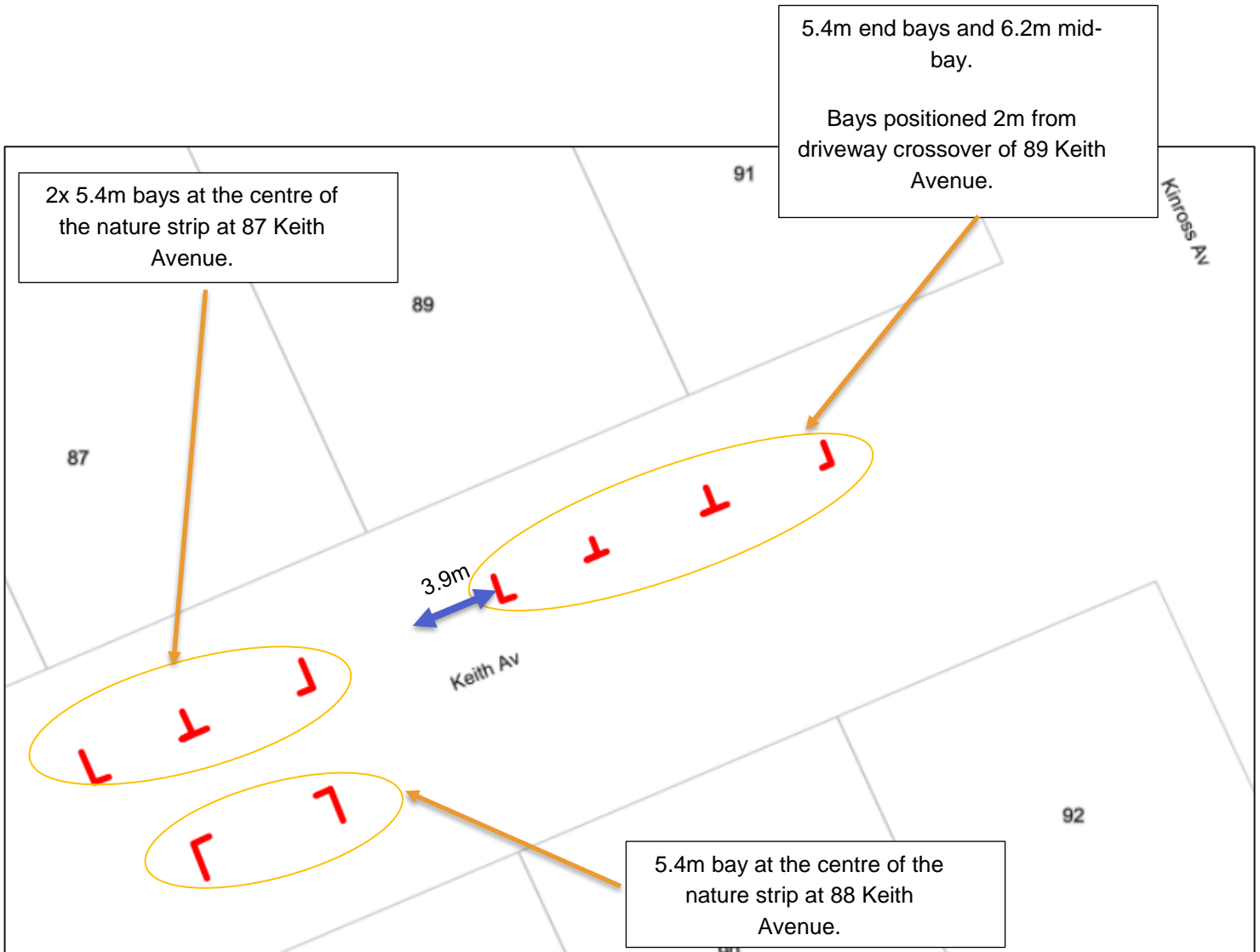
Option 1: Introduction of hockey stick line markings on Keith Street to provide guidance of onstreet parking spaces.
