## Correa Street, Edithvale – Proposed Parking Changes

### Background

Council is responding to concerns regarding parking on Correa Street in Edithvale.

### Council Action

Correa Street measures to be less than 7 metres wide, and therefore can only support parking on one side of the street whilst maintaining the required 3 metres minimum clearance for through traffic.

As such, Council is proposing to change the existing 'no stopping 10am-10pm Dec-Mar' restriction on the South (even number) side of Correa Street to a permanent 'no stopping' restriction.
