## Pine Crescent, Aspendale – Traffic Safety Improvement Measurements

### Background

Council is responding to community concerns regarding the pedestrian crossing safety on Station Street near Pine Crescent, Aspendale.

### Council Action

Council has conducted preliminary design of a pedestrian refuge island on Station Street and consulted with the relevant road authorities. The design was then modified and updated to meet the requirements. The finalised design includes:

1. A centre refuge island on Station Street south of Pine Crescent
2. A centre refuge island on Pine Crescent near Station Street
3. The existing bicycle lane will be modified
4. One parking space will be removed outside 22A Station Street. The updated design is shown in the next page.

The proposed traffic treatments will help to improve pedestrian crossing safety at the location, in particular for pedestrians that wanting to cross Station Street to reach the bus stop or the railway crossing. Please refer to the plan attached for more details.

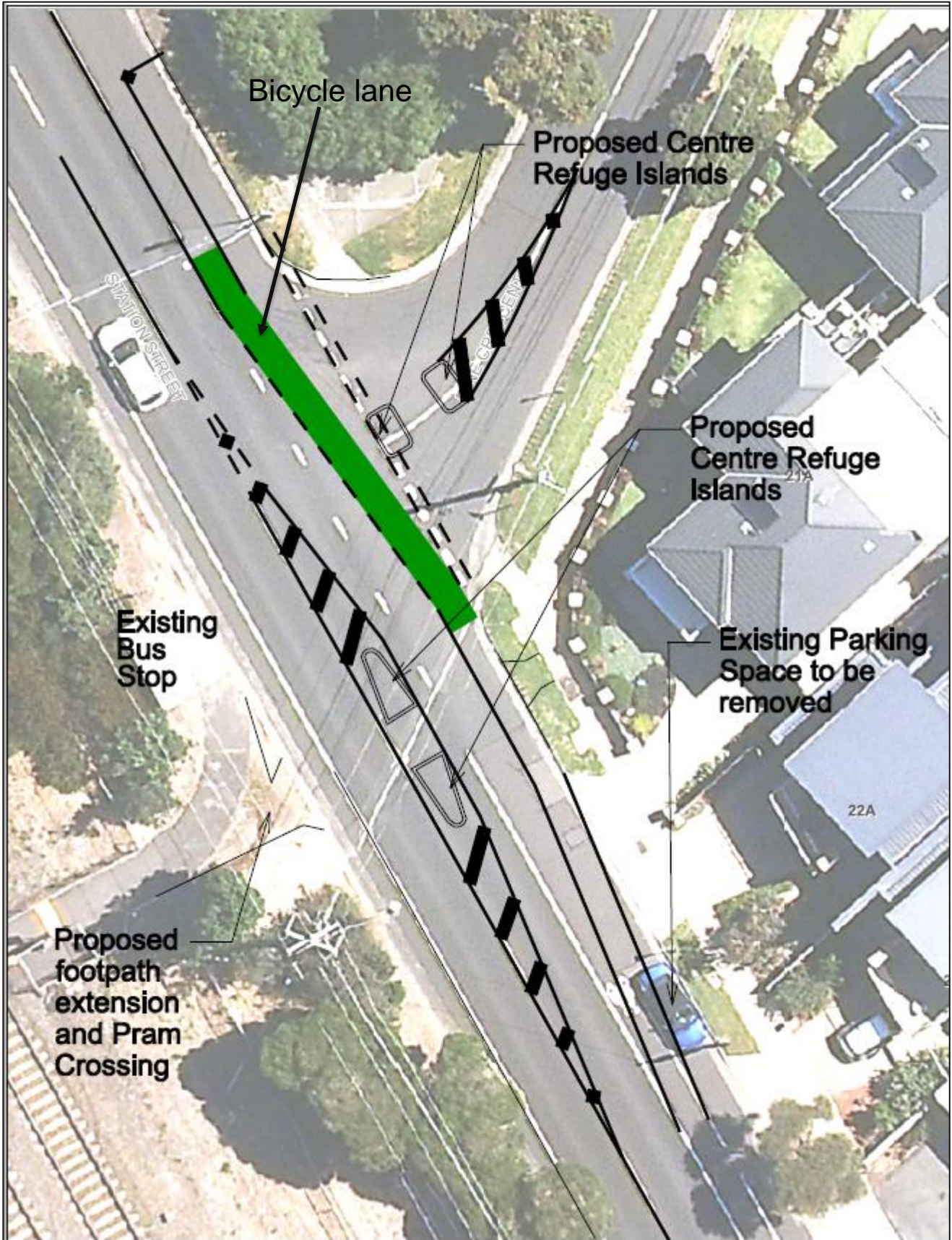
