Benkel Avenue, Cheltenham – Proposed parking restrictions

Background

Council is responding to community concerns regarding safety at the bend located on Benkel Avenue in Cheltenham, near No.56.

Council Action

An investigation has been undertaken, including an assessment of the line of sight at the bend. The assessment found that with car parking at the bend the sight lines are below the recommended standards.

To improve the sight lines, Council proposes to install 'No Stopping' signs on the bend in Benkel Avenue near No.56 (see plan over page for more details).

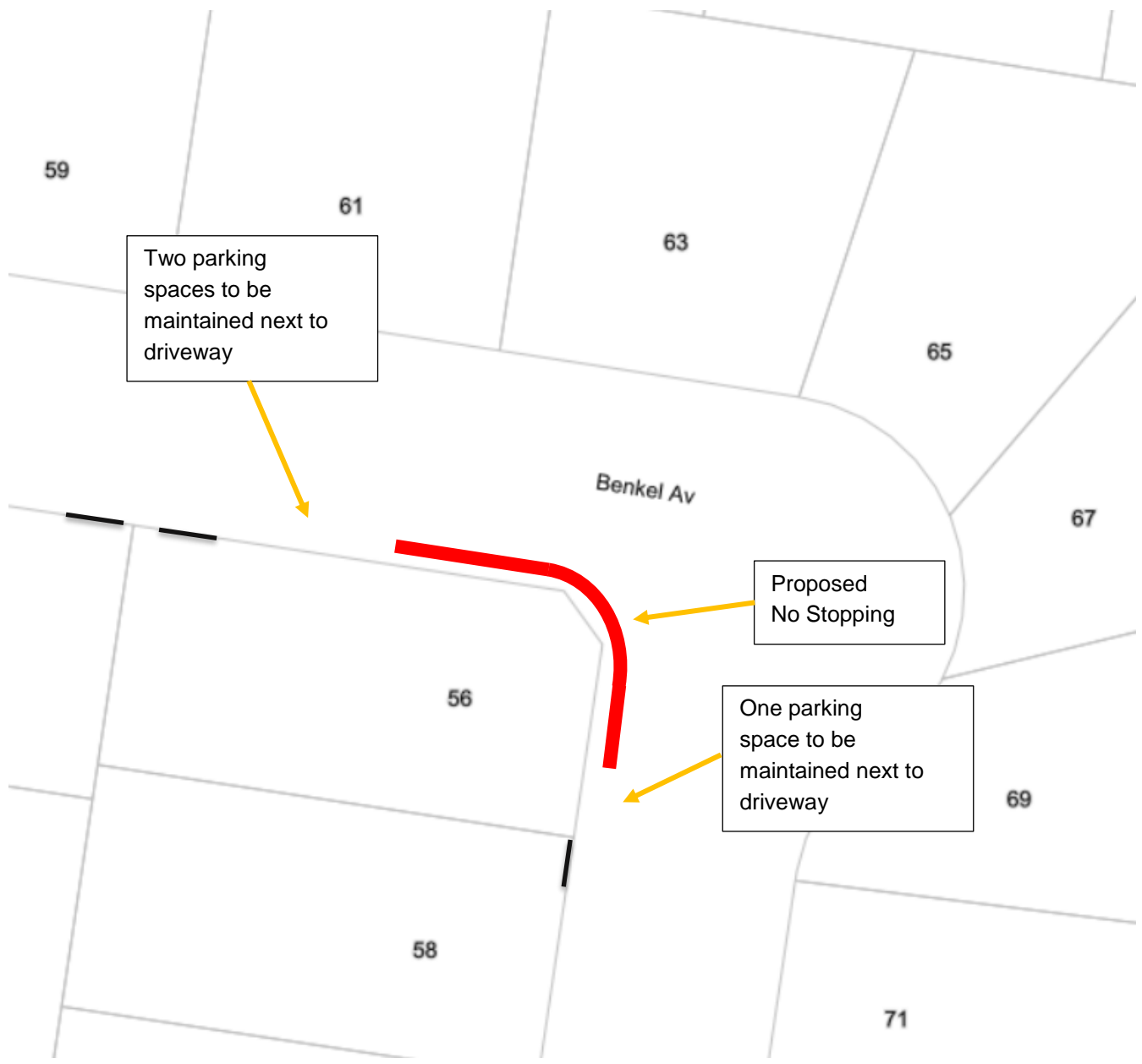
