Jolimont Place, Dingley Village – Parking Changes

Background

Council is responding to community concerns regarding parking in Jolimont Place, Dingley Village. Jolimont Place is measured at 5.9m, which is better suited for parking on one side of the road only.

Council Action

To address these concerns Council proposes a new parking layout for the street, with alternating parking spaces provided on both sides of the street between the traffic island and the eastern end of the road.

This approach is preferred to providing parking along one side of the street only, as it allows cars to pass while preventing motorists from speeding down the residential street.

A total of 16 parking spaces will be provided, including 7 on the south side and 9 on the north side of the street. A diagram has been provided over the page for your ease of reference.
