## Balcombe Road, Mentone – Proposed Parking Changes

### Background

Council is responding to concerns raised by local businesses regarding the current parking arrangements at 1-9 Balcombe Road in Mentone. To provide a balanced and flexible solution for the parking needs of all users, Council is proposing to make changes to the current parking arrangements.

### Council Action

Council is seeking your opinion on the following changes to 1-9 Balcombe Road (please see map overleaf):

- Restrict the hours of the existing loading bay to 7am-4pm and allow for 15-minute parking between 4pm and 8pm.
- Restrict the existing 5 2P restricted parking bays to 9am-4pm and allow 15-minute parking between 4pm and 8pm.

These changes aim to provide flexibility to the parking restrictions for the varying parking needs of visitors and local businesses throughout the day.

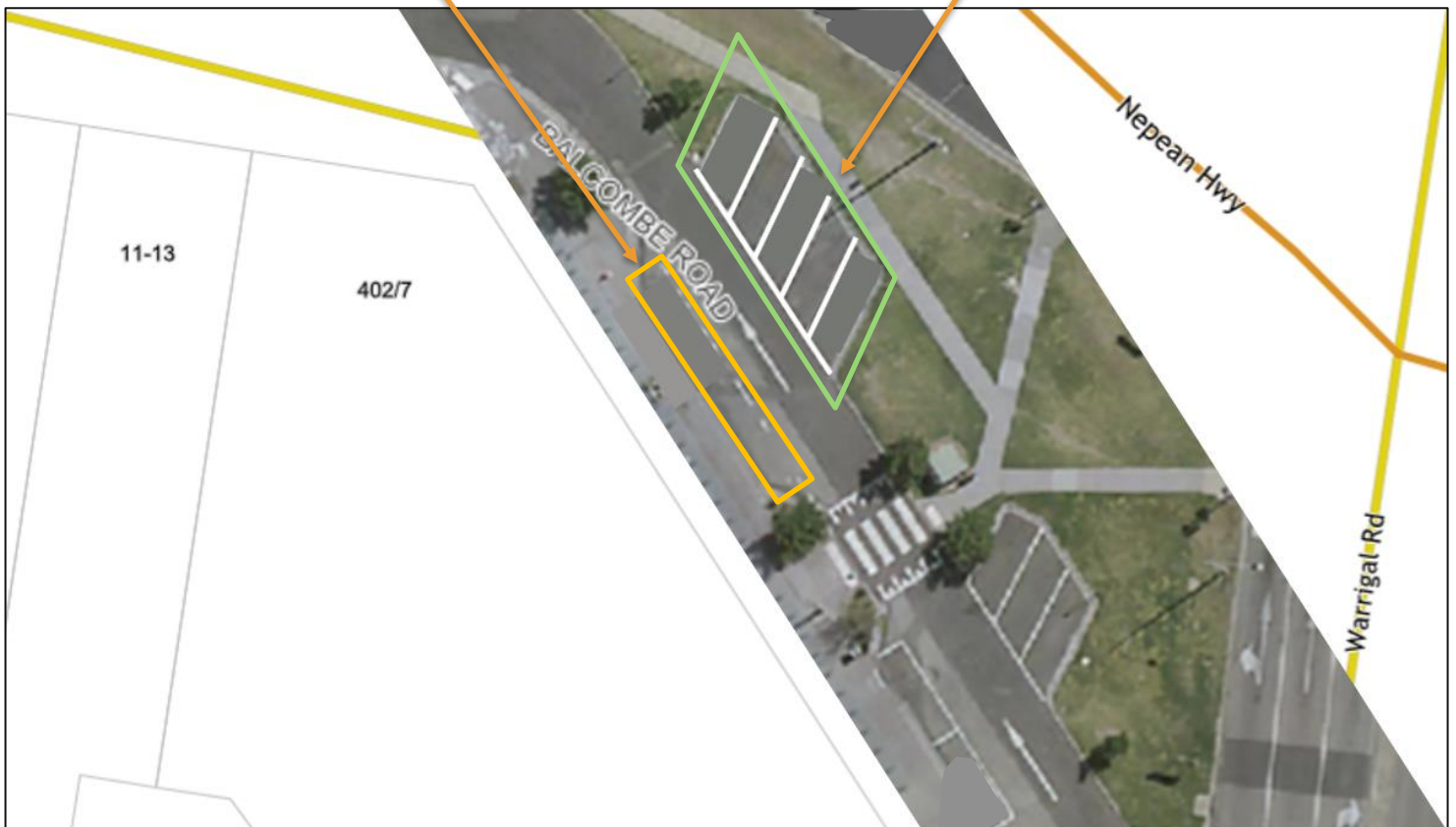
