Chandler Street, Parkdale – Proposed Changes to Traffic Island at Evan Street

Background

Council is responding to community concerns regarding pedestrian safety at the intersection of Chandler Street and Evan Street. Council has investigated this issue and found that vehicle and pedestrian safety could be improved at the intersection.

Council Action

To improve pedestrian and vehicle safety, Council is seeking feedback on the following proposed changes (see diagram over the page):

- Replace existing 'hatched' painted traffic island by extending the 'grass' island outside the shops and provide a pedestrian footpath;
- Install a small refuge 'splitter' island on Chandler Street at the Evan Street;
- Prohibit access from Evan Street into the road directly in front of the shops by 'no entry' signs.

These changes aim to increase safety for motorists and pedestrians in the area.

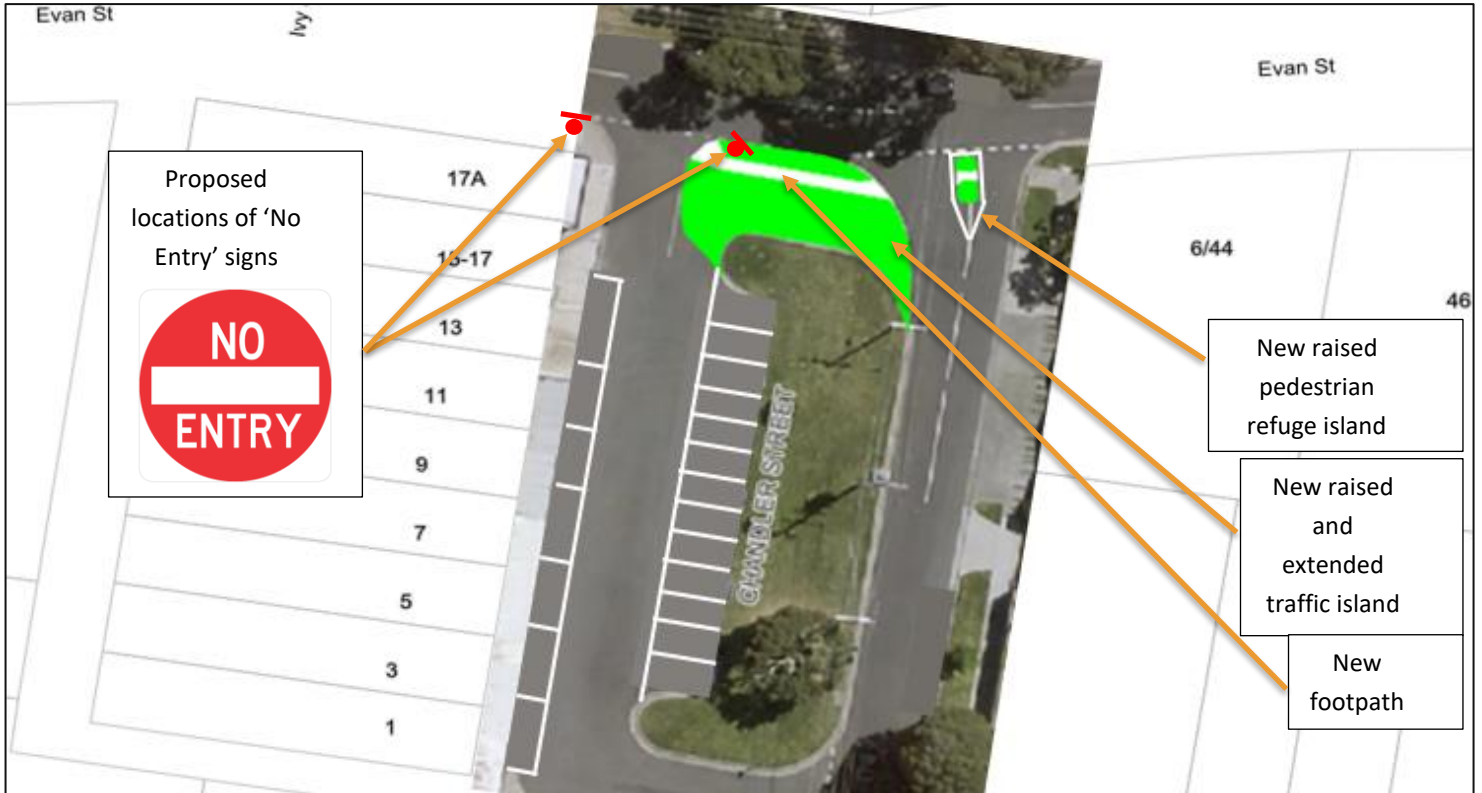
Have your say
