Christensen Street, Cheltenham – Parking Removal

Background

Council is responding to concerns from local businesses regarding safety on Christensen Street in Cheltenham. Large semi-trucks delivering to the local businesses on Christensen Street are experiencing difficulties entering and exiting the necessary properties due to the current parking arrangements on the street.

Council Action

Christensen Street is located within an industrial area. The width of this street is 7 metres wide, which is considered narrow given the street is used for industrial purposes.

Council has conducted an analysis to assess the entry and exit of large vehicles into private property in the street. The results showed that larger vehicle access into private property could be improved by the removal of parking. As such, Council will be implementing a no stopping zone between No.30-32 Christensen Street and No.26-28 Christensen Street (please see diagram overleaf).


This will improve safety and ease the entry and exit into private property for large delivery vehicles.

The 'no standing' signs will be installed within the next 2-4 weeks.
