Latrobe Street, Cheltenham / Mentone – Change to parking conditions

Background

In response to the temporary closure of Charman Road in November last year, Council installed temporary alternating No Stopping signs down the length of Latrobe Street, after receiving concerns about the traffic flow. We thank residents for their understanding and positive feedback following this measure.

The state government's Level Crossing Removal Project (LXRP) will be closing Charman Road again for approximately five weeks between Saturday 1 February and Friday 6 March 2020. In response to this, Council will again be changing the parking conditions in Latrobe Street for the duration of the closure to improve traffic flow.

Council Action

Council is proposing to install the following (please see image overleaf):

- Installation of “No Stopping 7am-7pm” on alternating sides of Latrobe Street

This change will only be in place for the duration of the upcoming Charman Road closure. **The signs will be installed on Friday 31 January and removed on Monday 9 March.**

Please note: if the closure ends before the scheduled date Council will endeavour to remove the signs early to return parking to residents, depending on contractor availability.
