### Council Action

Council is seeking your opinion on the following changes to Baxter Avenue (please see map overleaf):

**Option 1:** Extend the current '1/2P 8am-9pm Mon-Fri' at 18-20 Baxter Avenue to include weekends.

**Option 2:** No change to parking conditions.
