Jean Street, May Street Garfield Street & Sinclair Street, Cheltenham – Proposed Parking Changes

Background

In January 2017, Council consulted with local residents to propose extending the existing 1 hour timed parking restriction on Garfield Street, Jean Street, May Street and Sinclair Street to 2 hours. The result from this consultation showed that community support for this change varied. As such, Council chose not to proceed further with changes at the time.

Since this consultation, changes have been made to Council's Parking Management Policy such that properties are no longer entitled to receive visitor parking permits. Therefore, Council is now responding to community requests to the allow residents and visitors of Garfield Street, Jean Street, May Street and Sinclair Street, Cheltenham to park their vehicles on these streets longer than the current restricted hours. Council Action

Council has considered the special circumstances of the area and difficulties local residents are currently experiencing. To achieve a balanced outcome that serves the interests of both residents and visitors, Council proposes to extend the existing 1-hour time restriction to 3-hours. This will allow more time for both residents and visitors to park.

There will be no changes to residential permit entitlements. Eligible residents will continue to be able to apply for a residential parking permit to exempt them from the restrictions.
