Rogers Street, Mentone – Proposed Parking Changes

Background

Council is responding to community concerns regarding high levels of parking on Rogers Street in Mentone. To improve traffic and parking conditions, Council is proposing to make changes to the parking conditions on Rogers Street.

Council Action

Council is seeking your opinion on the following changes to Rogers Street (please see map overleaf):

Option 1: Replace existing '4P 9am-5pm Mon-Fri' parking restrictions with '2P 9am-5pm Mon-Fri' parking restrictions between Mitchell Street and Como Parade East.

Option 2: No change to parking conditions.




There will be no changes to residential permit entitlements. Eligible residents will continue to be able to apply to receive a residential parking permit to exempt them from the restrictions.
