Rosebank Avenue, Clayton South – Zebra Crossing

Background

Council is responding to community concerns about pedestrian safety and connectivity on Rosebank Avenue outside the shops close to Westall Station. The traffic improvement works include (see attached plan):

- A new pedestrian crossing with flashing lights on Rosebank Avenue (outside 150-152 Rosebank Ave) to help shoppers, school students and residents to cross Rosebank Avenue safely and to reduce vehicle speeds along Rosebank Avenue.
- Indented angled parking on the north side of the road.

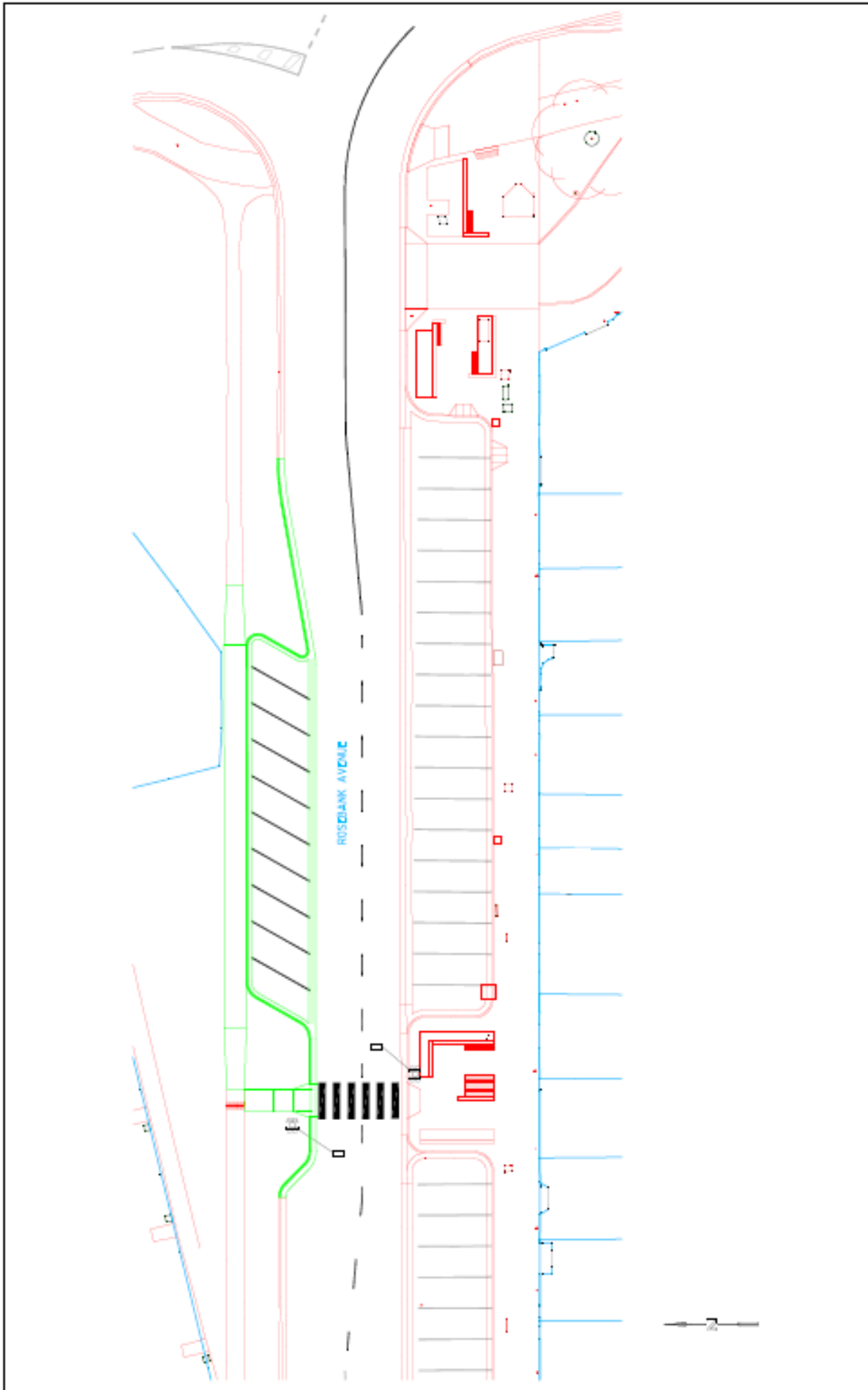
Council originally informed residents about these proposed traffic measures in 2017. Unfortunately, these works were delayed due to approvals required from VicRoads/Department of Transport and service utility companies.

The works will now be completed in the 2020-2021 financial year and residents will shortly be advised of a construction timeline.
