## Jackson Green Estate, Clayton South – Proposed change to parking conditions

### Background

Council is responding to community concerns about parking and traffic flow in the Jackson Green Estate in Clayton South. Therefore, to help improve the situation for residents, Council is proposing to change the current parking conditions within the estate.

### Council Action

Council seeks community feedback on the following proposal (see image over leaf for more information):

- Installation of “4P 9am-5pm” on the east side of:
  - Orchid Street
  - Dianella Street
  - Featherwood Street
  - Jackson Green Boulevard (between No.41 and Lomandra Drive)
- Installation of “4P 9am-5pm” on the south side of Jackson Green Boulevard (between No.3 and No.37)
- Installation of alternating “4P 9am-5pm”, No Stopping and unrestricted parking along the length of Lomandra Drive (see image for more detail)

**Please Note:** Residents living adjacent or opposite the restricted parking areas would be eligible for a residential parking permit to allow them to park within the restricted area.

Council’s Parking Management Policy allows for 2 residential parking permits per dwelling. The permits cost \$50 per year, with the fee waived for the first permit. Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, Council has placed a hold on fees for residential parking permits until 30 September 2020.

According to Council’s Parking Management Policy, all dual-occupancy and sub-divided lots granted planning advertisement after 28th of July 2015 are not eligible for residential parking permits. These developments are expected to have on-site parking as required under the Kingston Planning Scheme. Alternatively, you are also able to visit us at 1230 Nepean Highway to lodge your application.
