Proposed zebra crossing on Thames Promenade - west of Drinan Road, Chelsea

Background

In February 2019, in response to community concerns about pedestrian safety along Thames Promenade, Council proposed (amongst other measures) a zebra crossing with flashing lights to the east of Bertrand Road, Chelsea, and a reduction of traffic speeds on Thames Promenade from 60km/hr to 50km/hr.

The feedback received from residents and the wider community supported a zebra crossing close to the intersection and a speed reduction. However, several respondents raised safety concerns about the high number of drivers turning right from Drinan Road into Thames Promenade close to the proposed zebra crossing. The high number of drivers turning right out of Drinan Road into Thames Promenade (in comparison with the left turn out of Drinan Road and the right turn out of Bertrand Road) was confirmed by traffic counts at the intersection.

New location proposed – zebra crossing with flashing lights

In response to residents' concerns about safety for pedestrians crossing Thames Promenade, Council is proposing to relocate the zebra crossing with flashing lights, to the west of Drinan Road (please see map and example over the page). The installation of the zebra crossing will require the removal of a tree.
