Proposed traffic calming measures – Keith Street Parkdale

Council is writing to residents to provide an update on proposed traffic calming measures in Keith Street, and to gauge the level of support for the installation of two flat-top speed humps.

Background

In April 2019, Council sought feedback from residents on traffic management measures proposed in an area east of Nepean Highway bounded by Keith Street, Imes Street, MacGregor Street and Warren Road. These measures were proposed in response to resident's concerns about high volumes of non-local traffic using these roads as a cut-through between the Nepean Highway and Warren Road. Council proposed several traffic calming measures including flat-top speed humps and speed cushions along Imes Street, Chandler Street, MacGregor Street, Victoria Street and Keith Street.

In Keith Street (between Davey Street and Warren Road) two flat-top speed humps were proposed outside 49/68 and outside 61/80. The feedback in this section of Keith Street included resident concerns that the flat-top speed hump proposed outside 49 could result in overhead wires being pulled down by tall vehicles.

Earlier this year Council consulted with residents on plans to relocate the hump to outside 51/70 which also benefits from good street lighting and sufficient space between driveways to accommodate the speed hump. Feedback highlighted concerns regarding residential amenity if speed humps were installed in this location.

Council Action

Council is therefore undertaking further consultation with residents of Keith Street between Davey Street and Warren Road regarding their support for flat-top speed humps in this part of Keith Street. To be effective, at least two speed humps need to be installed.


