## Dyer Court and Mack Crescent, Clarinda – Proposed parking restrictions

### Background

In February, Council consulted residents after receiving concerns about poor sight lines in Dyer Court and Mack Crescent in Clarinda.

Council sought feedback on the following proposal:

- 'No Stopping' in Dyer Court on the south side – outside No. 18
- 'No Stopping' in Mack Crescent on the east side – Outside No.2 and No.4

### Council Action

The community feedback for proposal showed that there was strong support for the installation of the proposed No Stopping zones on Dyer Court and Mack Crescent.

Additional comments were made requesting an extension of the No Stopping zone, particularly around the intersection of Mack Crescent and Bodley Street. According to the Road Rules, parking is prohibited within 10m of an intersection and therefore to help reinforce this, Council will install No Stopping signs at this intersection.

Parking is however allowed on the continuous side of a 'T-intersection' and therefore a No Stopping zone outside No.2 and No.4 Bodley Street is not warranted.

Council will now proceed with the installation of the signs which should be complete within the next 2-4 weeks and improve the sight lines at these bends.
