## Governor Road, Braeside – Parking Removal Advisory

### Background

Council is responding to concerns from local businesses regarding large vehicle access in the service lane of Governor Road in Braeside. Large trucks delivering to the local businesses in the service lane of Governor Road are experiencing difficulties entering and exiting the necessary properties due to the current parking arrangements on the street.

### Council Action

This section of Governor Road is located within an industrial area. The width of this service lane is 7 metres wide, which is considered narrow given the service lane is used for industrial purposes.

Council has conducted an analysis to assess the entry and exit of large vehicles into private property in the street. The results showed that larger vehicle access into private property could be improved by the removal of parking. As such, Council will be implementing a no stopping zone on one side of a section of this service lane (please see diagram overleaf).


This will improve safety and ease the entry and exit into private property for large delivery vehicles.

The 'no standing' signs will be installed within the next 2-4 weeks.
