## Cheltenham area south of the activity centre – No change to parking conditions

### Background

In September 2019 and February 2020, Council consulted residents in the streets south of the Cheltenham activity centre about temporarily modifying the parking restrictions during the Level Crossing Removal Project. The proposed changes aimed to temporarily provide extra all-day parking in streets near Cheltenham station.

Council sought feedback on the following proposal:

Removing the 4P 8am-5pm timed parking restrictions on one side of the street to provide all-day parking on:

- The north side of:
  - Cameron Street
  - Page Street
  - Tuck Street
  - Hoffman Street (between Edward Street and Elman Street)
- The west side of:
  - Courtney Street
  - Hoffman Street (between Cameron Street and Tuck Street)
  - Nepean Highway Service Road

### Council Action

Council has reviewed the feedback from both rounds of consultation and the results showed that most residents did not support the proposed change to the parking restrictions.

Therefore, Council will not be proceeding with the change.

Council would like to thank all residents for providing feedback on this proposal.
